Year R Newsletter: 17th June 2022

What have we been learning about in Year R this week?

The children began the week by tasting turnips. We were pleasantly surprised that a lot of the children liked the turnips. They then completed some writing about whether they liked the turnips and what it tasted like.

In Maths the children have been sharing objects into groups. We have been sharing buttons between gingerbread. Each child to write a sentence to match the picture. Encourage children to complete the sentence independently. Men and paint brushes between children.

The children have also been completing some informal assessments this week in Phonics and Maths.

We have also been learning about different fruit and vegetables and discussing the different places they grow.

Next week:

We are going to be looking at farm animals and different jobs on the farm. The children will create some farming art work for a display in the classroom.

As part of our framing topic we are also very pleased to be having a 'Farm' day on Friday 24th June. A separate letter will follow.

The children will all be completing a writing assessment, which will be done in an informal way.

In Maths we will be learning about odd and even numbers. We will be counting groups of everyday objects and then deciding if they are an even or odd number of objects.
