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Year R Newsletter: 15th October 2021

What have we been learning about in Year R this week?

In Literacy the children have created their own story maps of 'Aaargh Spider'. They have also been thinking about changing the character of the spider to a different animal. They have been writing about how their new character might feel in the story. The children have had some wonderful ideas thinking of characters like bumble bees, caterpillars, dinosaurs and butterflies.

In Maths we have been looking at repeating patterns. The children have been looking at patterns already made and discussing what might come next in the pattern. They have also been creating their own repeating patterns using natural materials, pegs and peg boards, 'connecting camels' and even using their bodies to create movement patterns using different parts of the body.

The children have also been busy creating their own friendly messages to the spider in the story of 'Aaargh Spider'.

In PE the children became monsters. They created different monster shapes with their bodies, played a game of follow the monster (leader) and also practised balancing beanbags on our heads.

Next week:

In Literacy we will be exploring the book 'Bedtime for Monsters'. We will be exploring the vocabulary of the book and acting out the journey of the monster. We will also be drawing our own colourful monsters.

In Maths we will be looking at the numbers 1,2 and 3. We will be identifying different representations of these numbers and counting accurately up to 3 objects.
