Dear Parents

I am writing to you to provide you with a brief update on the schools plans for the proposed reopening on the 1<sup>st</sup> June.

Firstly, and essentially it is vital to recognise that the school will only open if the Government determines the five scientific measures have been met, therefore our planning which stems from the Government guidance is dependent on these and our preparations to ensure the health and safety of all pupils / staff and their families. We have already begun the process of planning for increased measures needed, be it hand washing / cleaning and distancing of pupils, and this plan will be provided to all parents in the near future.

The safety of our staff and students is our priority, and I hope that reiterating this makes it very clear that The Priory Primary School will not make any compromises that affect the safety of students, of staff or the wider community.

At this stage, one of the key factors in ensuring the safety of all pupils and staff, is the distancing of groups. Therefore, only pupils of Yr R, 1 & 6 (plus pupils registered as key worker / vulnerable children) will be considered for the re-entry process if The Priory is to open on 1<sup>st</sup> June. Siblings in different year groups would need to remain at home and continue with the Home Learning which will be provided for **ALL** students throughout this term.
