Get Electronic:

Computer games have changed over time but some of the old ones are still fun to play. Try Pacman here: <https://www.playpacman.org/game/online-pacman> and Tetris here: <https://www.classicgame.com/game/Tetris>

Get Researching:

Find out about the history of where you live? What was it like 50 or 100 years ago? Are there any new housing developments? Are there any new shops or businesses? How has this impacted on where you live?

Get Experimenting:

Grow a range of different vegetables. Suggestions are: peas, carrots, tomatoes and lettuce. Observe how they change as they grow from tiny seed to a full vegetable plant.

Get Cooking:

Follow a recipe. It could be for cakes, biscuits, sausage rolls, pies etc.. Change one of the ingredients to match your preferences. For example, instead of a raspberry muffin you may exchange raspberries for blueberries.

Get Writing:

Write about a big change that has happened in your life so far. Perhaps you have moved to a new house, school or country? Or you have had a new sibling, or someone has come to live with you. How did the big change make you feel at the time? Who did you talk to about it? How do you feel about the big change now looking back?
