Get Electronic:

Take a small toy such as a car on a journey just like the Naughty Bus. Take photos of your toy on the journey. You could print your photos and make your own picture book.

Get Researching:

Choose 4 different vegetables and research how they grow? Do they grow on a plant or under the ground?

Get Experimenting:

Put celery into a glass of water with food colouring. What do you think will happen?



Get Cooking:

Make your own vegetable soup. What vegetables will you use in your soup? What happens to the vegetables when you cook them?



Get Writing:

In the story The Gigantic Turnip, the old man and the old woman had help from lots of animals to tug the turnip out of the ground.

Write your own version of the story and list all of the people or animals that could help you tug a vegetable out of the ground.

Get Mathematical:

Plant a sunflower seed in a pot of soil or in your garden. As it grows, measure it with a ruler. You could keep a diary over the summer and draw and measure it as it grows.



Get Thinking:

Where do the vegetables that we buy in the supermarket come from? How do they get cleaned and packed into bags ready to sell? How are the vegetables picked when they are ripe?

Get Creative:

Make your own vehicle. Can you make the wheels turn round?



Get Active:

Go for a walk and count how many cars, lorries or buses you see on your journey. You could take a piece of paper and a pencil with you to keep a tally.



Get Performing:

Sing the song 'wheels on the bus go round and round' with actions. Can you use any props to help you perform the song? You could use the bell on your bike for the bus bell or two sticks for the wiper blades.
