What have we been learning about in Year R this week?

The children have been completing some writing activities this week. The children enjoyed describing some made up monster characters. They made up some interesting monsters and wrote some imaginative descriptions too.

In Maths the children were introduced to odd and even numbers. They were told that even numbers ended with a 0,2,4,6 or 8 and odd numbers ended with a 1,3,5,7 or 9. We used objects and put them into pairs for even numbers and found out that having an odd one out would be an odd number.
