What have we been learning about in Year R this week?

In Maths the children have been learning about 2D shapes. They have been learning about the properties of 2D shapes, sorting shapes, making 2D shape pictures and have been on a shape hunt. The children have also been working on prepositions and describing the position of different objects.

In Literacy the children have really got to know the story of 'Augustus and his Smile'. They enjoyed adding actions to help them remember the story and retelling the story using props in our outside area. We have also been creating story maps of 'Augustus and his Smile'. The children also then thought about what other things might make Augustus smile. They wrote down some suggested ideas of what might make him smile.

In PE the children enjoyed using hoops and turned them into bubbles. They enjoyed playing a game where they moved round the hall making sure they didn't pop anyone else's bubble. They also created different movements and putting them together to make a small dance sequence.

In Literacy we will be adapting the story of Augustus. We will be creating our own stories where we will go on our own journey to find our smiles. We will also be finding out different facts about tigers using non-fiction books and the internet.

In Maths we will be revisiting some of the work we have covered so far this term. We will also be counting forwards and backwards to 20, recognising numbers, matching numbers to the correct values and identifying shapes they see.
