You might like to swap the dried fruit in the recipe for chocolate chips.




Get Writing:

Get Mathematical:

Make 20 moon rocks by scrunching tin foil into a ball. Throw your moon rocks and see how many you can get inside a bucket or an empty box.

Challenge: Count how many moon rocks have landed outside of the box, how many must be inside the box if you started with 20.

Get Thinking:

Would you like to go into space? If you would, what would you like to do or see?

If you would not like to go into space explain why. You might like to draw a picture of space or a starry night sky.

Get Creative:

Make a 3D model of a planet. It could be a planet from the solar system or you could design your own planet.



Get Active:

Take a bucket out with you when you go on a walk and collect items that you find. If you visit a beach you could collect shells or pebbles. If you go for a walk in the woods collect items of different colours. Use your items to make a collage.

Get Performing:
