What have we been learning about in Year R this week?

We have read our core text 'Naughty Bus' and have taken some red buses on adventures round the school this week. In Maths the children have been working out a half of different shapes. They have been looking at different shapes with part of the shape shaded. The children also looked at half of different quantities e.g. if a child had 8 plastic frogs and half wanted to jump on a lily pad, how many frogs would be on the lily pad?

To finish the week we have enjoyed our pirate day with Year 1 and 2. The children have all looked wonderful in their costumes and have really got into the spirit of becoming a pirate for the day. Thank you for all your efforts with the children's fantastic costumes.
