What have we been learning about in Year R this week?

In Literacy we have begun our work on our first text 'Aaargh Spider'. The children have enjoyed listening to the story, been imagining what it would be like to be the spider on the ceiling and have been discussing what they like/dislike about the story.

In Maths we have been matching and sorting objects into different groups according to size, shape, colour and pattern. The children have been sorting different buttons, socks and other natural objects like pine cones and flowers.

We have also been on a spider hunt around the school. We enjoyed finding where spiders might live.
